Chalet Elbrus sleeps up 8 + 4 guests across five bedrooms.

Bedroom one

Master bedroom on second floor with en-suite bathroom, dressing room and balcony.

Bedroom two

Second master bedroom on second floor with en-suite shower room and balcony.

Bedrooms three and four

Double/twin bedrooms on first floor with en-suite shower rooms.

Bedroom five

Quad bunk room on first floor with en-suite shower room.

Breakfast is served each morning, to see you off on your way to the slopes and when you return, hearty ski snacks will be served to warm you through and keep you going until your evening meal.
