Villa Aurora has two things which make it really special: the beautiful, antique works of art in every room, and the wonderful gardens. Our favourite spot is the secret garden, hidden at the bottom of a stone staircase.

Immerse yourself in fragrant clouds of jasmine and rose in the secret garden of Villa Aurora, on the island of Capri. Once the summer residence of an illustrious Italian aristocrat, Villa Aurora is a whitewashed 17th century house which has been restored with refined elegance and a painterly eye.

Sensory overload is the only way to describe entering through the gates of Villa Aurora and into the lush paradise of its gardens. Just feast your eyes on the inviting swimming pool with its grotto fountains, shielded by pomegranate and palm trees. And all this is before you've even crossed the threshold. Inside, like a character in a Henry James novel, you find yourself drifting through sun-filled rooms, artfully decorated, with the discrete Villa Aurora staff in attendance.

Each of the seven large and luxurious suites is individually styled. Boiserie wall panels? A Venetian bookcase? Villa Aurora is owned by a renowned art and antiques dealer and is a treasure trove of paintings, sculptures and furniture. Behind the scenes, however, it is fully up to date, with high speed wireless internet, flat screen TVs and DVD players in every room.

No wonder Capri is a favourite retreat of Italy's rich and famous when such secluded, sun-drenched sanctuaries like this can be found. Sipping your morning coffee and delicious breakfast at a little table in the garden, looking out over the Bay of Naples, is a highlight of the day. With majestic Monte Solaro in the background and the little town of Anacapri a short walk away, the location is ideal for a special event, or a relaxing retreat.

Rooms

This luxury villa sleeps 14 people in 7 bedrooms across the main house and a garden annexe which is adjacent to the pool area.

All bedrooms have air-conditioning, TV/DVD player, safe and a mini-bar.

Bedroom one (Painter's room)
Twin bedroom (can be converted into a queen-sized bed) in the main house; en-suite bathroom with two antique bathtubs.

Bedroom two (Traveller's room)
Double bedroom with four poster bed in the main house; en-suite bathroom and terrace.

Bedroom three (Rialto room)
Double bedroom in the main house; en-suite with Turkish steam room and shower and terrace.

Bedroom four (Hunter's room)
Twin bedroom in the main villa; en-suite bathroom with Jacuzzi and terrace.

Bedroom five (French room)
Double bedroom with four-poster bed in the main house; en-suite bathroom with plunge room and terrace.

Bedroom six (Sea room annex)
Double bedroom with queen-sized bed (can be converted into twin beds) in the garden annex; en-suite bathroom with Roman bathtub and shower and small patio.

Bedroom seven (Garden room, guest annex)
Double bedroom with king-sized bed in the garden annex; marble bathtub in the bedroom, dressing area with stone shower and walk-in closet, small patio which leads to a private sundeck.

Eating

You'll awake to a daily complimentary breakfast at this luxury villa and for lunch and dinner your private cook is available throughout your stay to rustle up delicious meals for your party, featuring local Amalfi specialities. Ingredients are fresh and locally sourced – perfect for enjoying alfresco in the villas wonderful gardens.

If you prefer to dine out, Capri's wonderful restaurants are just a short walk away.

Location

Villa Aurora is in the small town of Anacapri, on the island of Capri. From Naples, there is a 45 minute hydrofoil trip to the island.

This luxury villa is just a 5 minute walk from the main square in Anacapri, via a beautiful old footpath through near the center of town. In Anacapri you will find the chair lift that ascends Mt Solaro, which offers the highest and most panoramic viewing point on the island.

Please note the the villa is accessible only by foot.
