Villa Mimosa sleeps up to 10 people in 5 en-suite bedrooms.

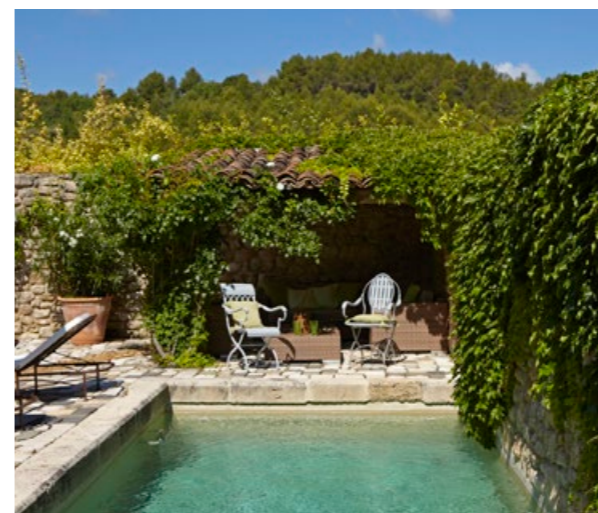
Two of the bedrooms are fixed doubles, one is a twin bedroom, and the other two can be configured as either a double or with twin beds.

If you wish to look after yourselves, it's easy to buy ingredients from the local shops in Menerbes and the regional food markets. And when you want to eat out, you can just wander over to the excellent restaurant of the 5 star hotel.

Breakfast and an afternoon snack is included in the rental cost of this villa, so you don't even have to venture out every morning in search of fresh croissants from the boulangerie. All your breakfast treats and freshly brewed coffee await you when you wake up, served by your friendly yet discrete housekeeper.

You can order meals to be delivered to Villa Mimosa, straight from the hotel kitchen, if you prefer to have a 'restaurant at home' experience. Children have plenty of nooks and crannies to explore at Villa Mimosa. The Luberon National Park is a great place for sports activities such as horse riding, and hiking, and you can even hire electric bikes to explore the region's network of cycle paths. If kayaking along the Luberon river sounds like good family fun, you can take guided excursions from Aix-en-Provence.
