Schongraben (first floor): Double/twin bedroom with en-suite bathroom, private balcony and sofa which transforms into bunk beds.

Albona (first floor): Double/twin bedroom with en-suite shower room, private balcony and sofa which transforms into bunk beds.

Rosshall (lower ground floor): Double/twin bedroom with en-suite bathroom and balcony.

Matton (lower ground floor): Double/twin bedroom with en-suite bathroom.

Verwall (lower ground floor): Double bedroom with en-suite bathroom.

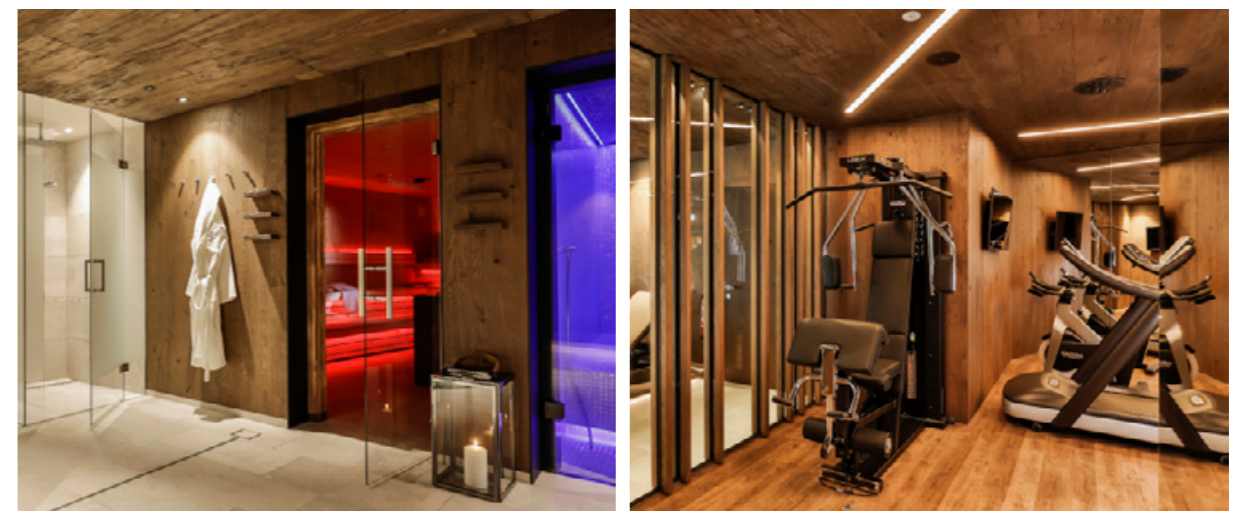
## Eating

Chalet Lena is set in the quiet, upmarket Nasserein area of St Anton, so you'll be just a few minutes' chauffeured drive from the Nassereinbahn lift station.

The best thing about the location here is the proximity to the snow. You can be up in Gampen via the Nasserein lifts after a swift roll out of bed in the morning, but if you want to explore further afield there's a shuttle service into St Anton from where the whole Ski Arlberg area and the resorts of Lech and Zurs are there to be explored.

The nearest airports are Innsbruck approx. 1hr 15mins away and Zurich approx. 2hrs 30 mins away.
