We love the views at Haus Leyton. It looks out over the pretty rooftops of Zermatt and you can see the Matterhorn looming over it all in the distance.

Contemporary design meets classic comfort in this rather special luxury ski chalet in Zermatt. Offered on a self-catered basis, Haus Leytron is a truly cosy and intimate duplex apartment, which is perched in the exclusive Petit Village area of Zermatt, accessed by 24-hour funicular.

The immense floor-to-ceiling windows give you wonderful views from the stunning living area. This double-height, open-plan space is ideal for entertaining, whether you're relaxing on the capacious sofas, warming yourself before the log fire or sitting at the piano tinkling the ivories. And there's nothing like that view of the Matterhorn to inspire a tune or two!

The modern and stylish dining space is big enough to seat everyone in comfort, so you and friends and family can happily linger all evening over a leisurely meal. A fully equipped kitchen means that you can cater for yourself.

While this luxury chalet makes for a wonderfully sociable entertaining

space, there's also room to find a quiet corner to yourself whenever you need it. A stunning sweeping staircase leads to the upper floor, which overlooks the living area and has a cosy desk space, perfect for escaping to with a book or the newspapers (and maybe a glass of something to warm you through after a day on the slopes).

The upper level also houses the chalet's three luxe bedrooms, all decked out in sumptuous fabrics and with only the puffiest pillows and cosiest duvets to keep you warm all night. Each bedroom is a lovely retreat in which to cocoon yourself, but we suggest you get there early to bag the room with the steam sauna in the en-suite. Total bliss!

A south-facing balcony puts the icing on the cake of this truly stunning luxury ski chalet. Sneak out there with your after-dinner drinks to watch the lights twinkling on over Zermatt and marvel at how the dark mass of the Matterhorn seem to touch the stars that hang above.



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Rooms

Haus Leytron sleeps six adults and four children across 4 bedrooms

Bedroom one

Spacious master bedroom on top floor with TV and balcony; en-suite with bath and separate shower and steam sauna.

Bedrooms two and three

Double/twin bedrooms on top floor, each with stunning views from floor-to-ceiling windows, and balconies; en-suite bathrooms with baths.

Bedroom four

Children's bunk room on lower floor with four bunk beds and decorated with children in mind; separate shower room and WC.

Zermatt is a lovely, car-free location, making it a really great choice for families. In the afternoons, when they are finished on the slopes, there's cable TV and a DVD player so kids can watch a movie matinee together while you enjoy the steam sauna and relax ahead of your evening meal.

Location

Haus Leytron is set in the peaceful Petit Village area of Zermatt, overlooking the village. The property is accessed by 24-hour funicular or a 3mins electric taxi journey from the village.

Advanced skiers can ski (off piste) to within a short walk of the chalet in the right conditions.

Zermatt is a car free resort, so access is usually via train from the last stop at Tasch. The train from Tasch to Zermatt takes just 10 minutes. Alternatively we can arrange a private vehicle all the way into Zermatt main train station from the airport.

Sion airport (regional) is 1.5 hours away, and Geneva is approximately 3h and 30 minutes drive away.
