The island in the centre of the lake makes for the perfect picnic spot, a finish line for a stand-up paddle boarding race or a spot of catch and

release fishing.

Inside the traditional country house, you can truly make yourself at home. The glow of roaring fires on cooler days glimmers against enviable libraries and a grand billiard table, and you can pick from the drawing room or the striking octagonal room for a pre-dinner lounge. Tinkling ice against crystal glasses signals the start of the evening as you help yourself to the open bar, with tipples tailored to your choice. Wine connoisseurs will love the historical wine cellar, where a tasting can be arranged, and kids will love the cinema room for exciting movie nights. With a house manager and chef ready to cater to all your needs, you won't have to stop enjoying all the house has to offer to prepare dinner. Simply decide when you would like to dine and the rest is taken care of.

First Floor

Master Bedroom

King sized bedroom with walk-in wardrobe, sitting area and en-suite bathroom with bath and shower.

Parrot Bedroom

King sized bedroom with sitting area and en-suite bathroom with bath. Can be configurable as a twin.

Red Four Poster Bedroom

King sized bedroom with separate bathroom down the hall with toilet and bath.

Blue Four Poster Bedroom

King sized bedroom with en-suite bathroom with bath, shower and double vanity.

Two-bedroom suite consisting of Lady Clem Bedroom and Bird Bedroom

Lady Clem Bedroom with large single bed and en-suite bathroom with shower and bath shared with Bird Bedroom. Can be used as a dressing room.

Bird bedroom with double bed and en-suite bathroom with shower and bath shared with Lady Clem Bedroom.

An additional shower room is

available on this floor.

Second Floor

Top Octagonal Bedroom

King sized bedroom with sitting area and separate bathroom directly across the corridor with bath and shower.

Green Bedroom

King sized bed and en-suite bathroom with en-suite with bath. Can be configurable as a twin.

Blue Bedroom

Double bed with en-suite bathroom with shower.

Two-bedroom suite consisting of Chinese Bedroom and Toile Bedroom

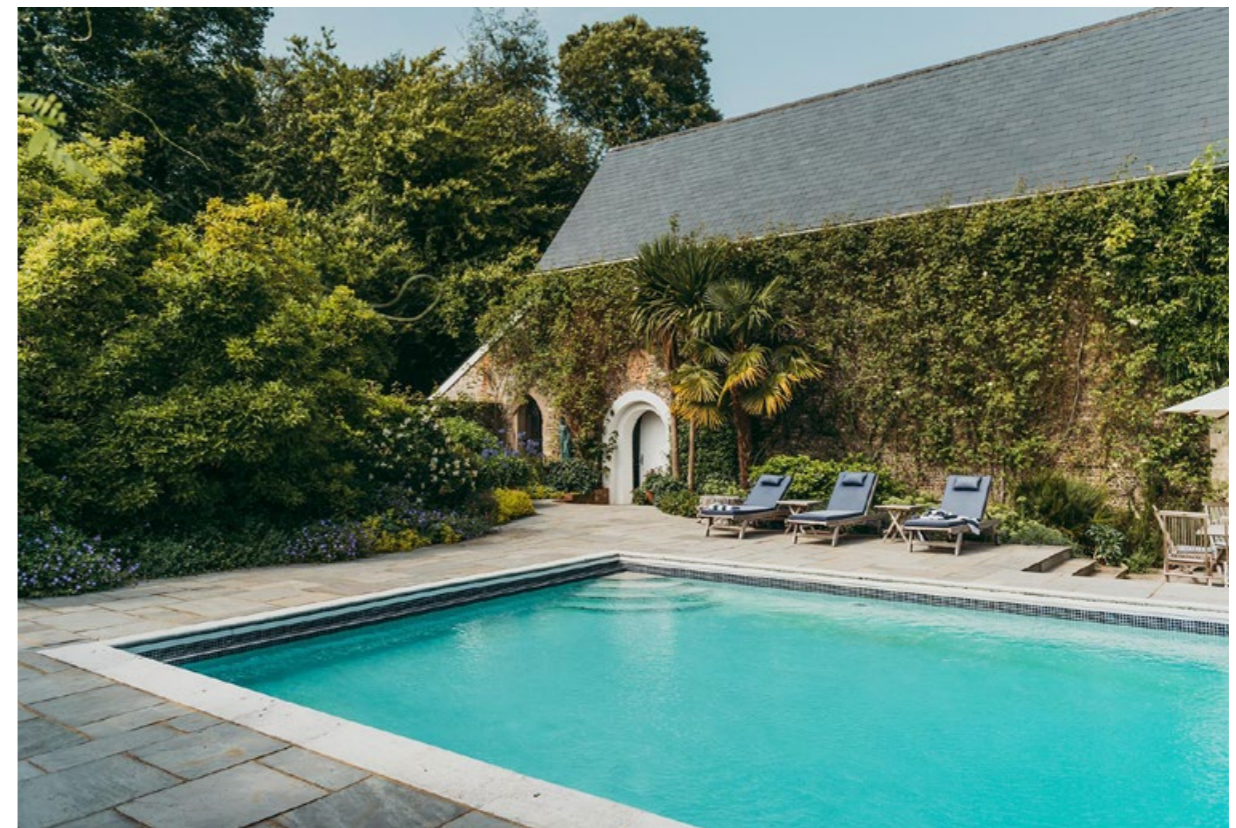
